Research shows that the reading skills of students who do not read over the summer months may decline significantly. The American Library Association lists benefits to readers in a summer reading program. Based on that list, CCS encourages reading during the summer to provide:

- encouragement for a lifelong habit of reading
- encouragement to read for enjoyment
- learning for personal interest
- maintenance and growth in reading skills
- an opportunity for family time, discussion, and bonding

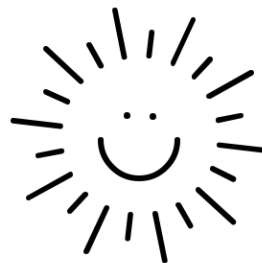
Although reading is its own reward, it is nice to have an incentive! Those who read the minimum number of pages and turn in their summer reading logs will be invited to a movie based on a book. It will take place during the school day in the library and will include refreshments.

Reading logs are due by the end of the first week of school. Once the student has met the challenge, it is not necessary to continue adding to the log unless you or they just enjoy keeping a record.

Here are the minimum page count requirements per grade level to attend the back to school movie with refreshments:

Rising K	300
Rising 1 st	450
Rising 2 nd	550
Rising 3 rd	650
Rising 4 th	800
Rising 5 th	1000

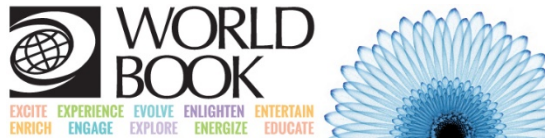
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Looking for books?
